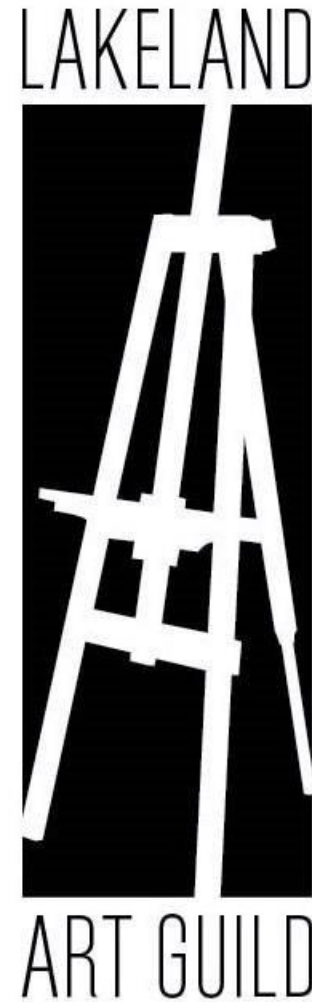

ENTRY GUIDELINES

ORIGINALITY

All entries must be original work completed within the last 5 years (NEW: can be previously shown in RPFunding show and have never won an award).

Copies and reproductions of original works of art, whether embellished or not, are not eligible for submission to juried exhibitions. Please be mindful of copyright infringements – BE ORIGINAL. Lakeland Art Guild retains the right to photograph artwork as necessary to promote the organization, events, and shows. All works must remain on exhibition until pickup date unless sold.

SIZE

Maximum size of 2D art work is to be no larger than 36" in width including frame. LAG provides pedestals for 3D artwork. However, the artist must provide for works with any special display requirements.

FRAMING

All 2D work must be framed or gallery wrapped with finished edges and no staples showing. Frames must be in good condition (no scratches or loose corners). Mats must be clean and smoothly cut. Plexiglas or glass is acceptable in framing. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS! Screw eyes and hanging wire MUST be attached firmly to the back of the piece.

SALES

There is a 30% donation requested based on the sales price of any work sold during the show. No POR please.

JUDGING

The judge is solely responsible for the works selected at his/her discretion and for all awards.
